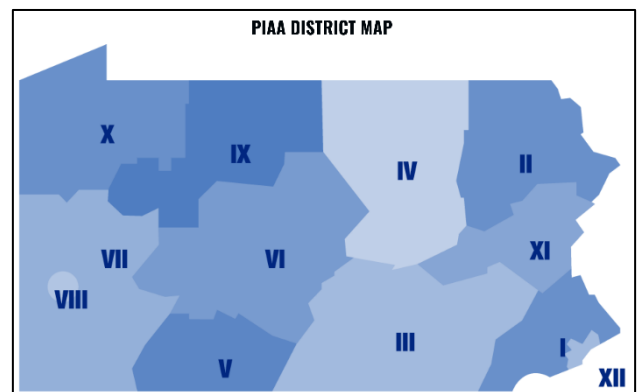


PSBA seeks members to serve on PIAA District Committees and PIAA Board of Directors

PSBA seeks members interested in serving as the school board representative to their local PIAA District Committee and a representative of the membership to serve on the PIAA Board of Directors. Please follow the links below to download and complete the application for either appointment. All applications are due to PSBA no later than March 15, 2019.

Article IX of the PIAA Constitution outlines that each district committee shall include a member of a school board from the district. School director representatives are full voting members of their respective district committees. The term for each of the 12 district representatives begins July 1, 2019, and runs through June 30, 2021. The PIAA Constitution outlines the following roles/responsibilities of the district committees:

- To have general control within the District over all interscholastic athletic relations and Contests in which a PIAA member school participates, subject to the provisions of the rules and regulations of the Board of Directors.
- To investigate, hear, and decide matters in dispute between PIAA member schools located within the District. The District will not consider matters submitted more than one year after the dispute arose. No officer or member of the District Committee is eligible to vote in case of a dispute involving such officer's or member's school or public school district.
- To receive, request, or require data on alleged violations of the Constitution, By-Laws, Policies and Procedures, and Rules and Regulations by or from schools located within the District.
- To make determinations as to the eligibility of contestants, and to address alleged violations of the Constitution, By-Laws, Policies and Procedures, and Rules and Regulations of PIAA.
- To fix and enforce penalties, within the District, for violation of the Constitution, and By-Laws, Policies and Procedures, and Rules and Regulations of PIAA, within the limits prescribed by the By-Laws.
- To have general control of District Championship Contests.
- To act with the Board of Directors in the transfer of schools from one District to another.
- District committees generally meet 10 times per year – monthly with one meeting over the Summer



PSBA district committee representatives are asked to participate in a quarterly conference call with the PSBA representative to the PIAA Board of Directors and attend an in-person meeting once per year conducted in conjunction with the PSBA School Leadership Conference.

In addition to representation on each PIAA District Committee, PSBA is also granted the authority to appoint a member to the PIAA statewide Board of Directors. This position represents the interests and views of school directors before the statewide body. The PIAA Board meets every other month for a total of six meetings per year. The PSBA representative is appointed by the PSBA Governing Board for a term of two years and is eligible for reappointment. The next term of appointment will begin July 1, 2019, and run through June 30, 2021.

PSBA shall accept submissions of interest from eligible candidates to serve on their district committee or as the PSBA representative to the PIAA Board until 4:00 p.m. on March 15, 2019. For consideration, please fill out the appropriate application linked below and submit it to:
